## Disqualification and Revocation of Results of 2006 IDSF World Standard Championship

Following the positive test results of the Anti-Doping control performed re: Ms. Edita Daniute, of Lithuania, at Stuttgart, Germany on August 19, 2006 and the subsequent decisions of the IDSF Disciplinary Council and the Court of Arbitration for Sport, of Lausanne, Switzerland, the results which Ms. Daniute and her partner Mr. Arunas Bizokas achieved in the IDSF Grand Slam Standard Competition held in Stuttgart, Germany in August, 2006 and in the 2006 IDSF World Standard DanceSport Championship held at Aarhus, Denmark, on November 25, 2006, have been disqualified and revoked, and IDSF's records have been amended to show the results after those disqualifications are taken into account, including:

- **the complete revocation of the 2006 IDSF World Standard Championship**, medals and IDSF World Ranking List points awarded to **Mr. Bizokas & Ms. Daniute**,
- **the retroactive award** of the 2006 IDSF World Standard Championship, medals and corresponding World Ranking points, to **Mr. Paolo Bosco & Ms. Silvia Pitton**, of Italy,
- the corresponding raising of all placings and any medals and awards in the 2006 IDSF World Standard Championship, by one level, so that the Runners-Up are **Mr. Sascha Karabey & Ms. Natascha Karabey**, of Germany, and the third-place finalists are **Mr. Benedetto Ferruggia & Ms. Claudia Koehler**, and
- the complete revocation of awards, medals and prize money received by Mr. Bizokas & Ms. Daniute at the IDSF Grand Slam at Stuttgart in August, 2006.

IDSF joins the rest of the DanceSport world in congratulating Mr. Paolo Bosco & Ms. Silvia Pitton on their officially winning the 2006 IDSF World Standard DanceSport Championship.
