### IDSF First Vice President Stood Down From Duty

On July 8, 2005 the IDSF Presidium approved a Motion by IDSF President Rudolf Baumann under Article 14 of the *IDSF Statutes* to temporarily suspend all of Mr. Harald Frahm's powers and authority as IDSF 1st Vice President and Member of the IDSF Presidium, with immediate effect, until the allegations of corruption against him in the Jurgen Emig affair in Germany are fully and finally resolved to the satisfaction of the IDSF Presidium, and his name is cleared of any wrongdoing.

This does not mean that Mr. Frahm has resigned or that the Presidium has removed him from office, but rather that all of his powers and authority are suspended while he concentrates on clearing the allegations recently published with respect to him in the European media regarding this matter, according to normal practice for persons who occupy a public or corporate office or any position of high authority, who are accused of wrongdoing.

Mr. Frahm has assured the President and the Presidium that the allegations against him are without foundation and that he is defending against them vigorously in the German Courts.
