Several WDSF events have been held during the last months in Chile,


Ecuador, Argentina and I'm proud to announce that for the first time ever a

This year, Cyprus, Malaysia and San Marino have been granted full membership of WDSF.

The Membership Commission continues to provide trainers for the development and promotion of DanceSport in the following countries:


ECUADOR

- 4 Standard training courses for national athletes
- 2 Conferences for national judges
- 4 Training courses were attended for foreign athletes from 7 countries.

- Average of 170 athletes participating.
- The organization provided internal transfers to all delegations, plus lodging, meals and transfers to 10 athletes per country.

Two national Judges attended the WDSF Adjudicators Congress in November 2011 and obtained WDSF Adjudicator Licenses.


Ecuadorian athletes attended the WDSF Open in Buenos Aires (Argentina) and the WDSF Open in Santiago (Chile).



Attendance in a Sports Management course in Coldeportes. This is a legal requirement in order to be a Sports Director in Colombia. (40 Hours)

The Municipality of Cali allocated a training place in the city, a space inside the Coliseum "EL PUEBLO".

A National Competition Model with the respective justification was created and presented to COLDEPORTES in order to obtain necessary permissions to perform a competition without previous recognition.

BRAZIL

Our WDSF Trainer, Eva Angües, has continued with her excellent work in this country.

Trainers and Adjudicators Congresses were held and will be repeated during July - August 2012.

The development in Brazil is very good and we hope that we can be able to organize WSF competition next year in Sao Paulo.

MEXICO

Our PD athlete, Isaac Rovira, will continue with his formation congresses in Mexico during July 2012.

The improvement of quality has been tremendous and we hope we can see Mexican athletes participating in WDSF events worldwide very soon.
