The work as WDSF Sports Director has changed quite a lot during the last year, especially for all the new projects including the World Games and the WDSF World DanceSport Games.



website, publicity, broadcasting of the events, press releases and


conferences.

The preparation for these Games is running very good and I can assure that this will be a great MultiSport event.


#### **JUDGING SYSTEM 2.0**

## **ID CARDS**


#### Goals

- Avoiding the need of signing the athletes' form of consent by every athlete at every competition.
- Clear identification of an athlete/couple by using a unique number instead of inconsistently spelled names and surnames.
- Reliable information about the date of birth and nationality of all athletes.
- Efficient registration and check-in procedures.
- Legal coverage for media publishers at WDSF events.
- Membership awareness of athletes.
- Responsibility awareness of national administrators.

#### Management

With feedback from many national administrators the management website for ID-Cards was enhanced with:

- Information about duplicate entries of ID-Card applications
- Information about ID-Card application without MIN where a MIN might exist
- Sending of customized emails to ID-Card applicants by status and date

- Uploading of application documents
- Access for national administrator assistants
- Communication for status changes to administrators
- Link management (temporary ID-Card, Status, Application form, PDF)
- Removal of invalid applications

#### **TECHNICAL BOOKS:**

A group of professional dancers as well as the WDSF PD with several experts on Technical questions were consulted to make this second edition of the WDSF Technique Books.

My work was to overview the whole procedure and I must congratulate all involved persons for the fantastic books which will guide and unify the DanceSport knowledge in the future.

Due to these Technical Books a licenses system as well as an education system was created for Trainers and Adjudicators.

We hope we can be able to start selling at the WDSF Adjudicators Congress in Stuttgart.

# **CHAIRMAN HANDBOOK**

After the realization of the new Competition Rule Book, the WDSF Sports Commission started immediately to work in the Chairman Handbook. I would like to thank my colleagues at the Sport Commission, especially Wolfgang Eliasch, for their help and valuable input.

This Chairman handbook is a living book and a guideline to act correctly under certain circumstances, making our WDSF Competitions even better.

**NEW AGE GROUP** 


The Sports Commission will present to this 2013 AGM a new age group schedule, trying to find a better year distribution in our groups.

**GRAND SLAM SERIES 2013-2017:** 

Detailed information about Grand Slams 2013-2017 can be found in our WDSF  $\mathbf{1}^{\text{st}}$  Vice-President report.

It is important in addition to committing by 5 years period, that the organizers will hold these events on fixed dates and at the same venue every year.

The WDSF Grand Slams must have a common branding and presentation which identifies them with the first class product it is. This also offers higher possibilities for TV coverage worldwide.







These events are the most important competitions not only on the Prize money scale but also for the World Ranking List.

### **CERTIFICATION OF PDA'S SYSTEMS**

The WDSF Sports Commission, together with Olav Groehn, has worked on the requirements for WDSF certification of scrutineering software.

All scrutineering programs used in WDSF events must comply with these requirements by January 2013.

### **WORLD RANKING LIST COMPETITIONS**

Several ideas have been brought up for the creation of a world ranking system (WRL) which can be used for Oceania and America.

During the next month, the implementation of such a system will be followed.
